



CAVALLERIZZE

Placed alongside the submarine Enrico Toti, between the Monumental building and the Air&Water Transport Building, the Cavallerizze (historical stables) are the result of a recent restoration process, in the context of contemporary urban redevelopment.

Built in the 1800s after the Olivetan monastery was turned into barracks, the space is characterised by large open volumes, evocative bare brick walls and large luminous windows. The space is suitable for large scale events, exhibitions and conferences.








CHIOSTRI

Located on level 1 of the Monumental Building, the two twin cloisters preserve the ancient beauty of the sixteenth century monastery.

Overlooking two gardens and dominated by the steeple of the San Vittore church, the cloisters give the chance to enjoy discreet social events in a secret corner of Renaissance Milan.

The Cloisters are outdoors but sheltered from the rain












AUDITORIUM

In this renovated multipurpose space, located on level 1 of the Monumental Building, the elegance of the 1950s original structure is enhanced by modern technical equipment and furnishings. It represents an ideal setting for conferences, seminars and cultural activities. Next to the entrance is the Regina Margherita space, which can comfortably host coffee breaks and cocktails.










SALA DEL CENACOLO



Located on level 1 of the Monumental Building and overlooking the cloister, the ancient refectory of the monastery is entirely decorated with stucco and frescoes by Pietro Gilardi, evoking the baroque splendour of the eighteenth century.

The impact of colours and details creates the ideal atmosphere for inspiring events. The area in front of the hall, known as Anticenacolo, can host coffee breaks and cocktails.

AREA 220 sq.m. **CAPACITY** 90 people












TINKERING ZONE



Located on level 1 of the Monumental Building, the Tinkering Zone is a workshop dedicated to the innovators of the future.

Tinkering is a way to explore, understand and change the world. It is a method that works at the intersection between art and science, integrating technology, engineering and design. The space is suitable for workshops, press previews and small presentations.

AREA 85 sq.m. **CAPACITY** 30 people










SALA DELLE COLONNE



Located on level 2 of the Monumental Building, in the heart of the Galleria Leonardo, this was once the library of the Olivetan monastery. It is a fascinating hall, overlooking two beautiful Renaissance cloisters. The geometrical architecture, marked by a succession of arches and columns, makes this space ideal for hosting exhibitions and exclusive events.

AREA 600 sq.m. **CAPACITY** 300 people












SALA DELLE COLONNE

TEMPORARY SET-UP



From 11.09.2018 to 28.02.2019 Sala Colonne will host a temporary set-up with 10 fascinating historical models of Leonardo da Vinci machines exhibited in the two side aisles. The central nave can be used as an evocative space for presentations or gala dinners.



Located on level 2 of the Monumental Building, with access from Via San Vittore, this is a modular space ideal for exhibitions, product launches, screenings and performances.








AREA 350 sq.m. **CAPACITY** 130 people



SPAZIO POLENE





It is at the centre of the Air & Water Transport Building, dominated by beautiful figureheads and by the bridge-front of the ocean liner Conte Biancamano and AC72 Luna Rossa catamaran, with a dedicated entrance from Via Olona 6a. The Building, which houses some of the most important and fascinating objects of the Museum, offers a charming and picturesque setting for cocktails and appetizers.

700 standing (whole pavilion)










SALA CONTE BIANCAMANO





In the imposing setting of the Air & Water Transport Building, with a dedicated entrance from Via Olona 6a, is an impressive original sector of the ocean liner Conte Biancamano.

Inside is this ballroom, with a peculiar circular shape that evokes the atmospheres of the 1930s. The space is ideal to host gala dinners and press conferences.

AREA 350 sq.m. **CAPACITY** 100 people











EXHIBITION AREA A-1





Located on level -1 of the Air & Water Transport Building, with direct access from the Spazio Polene, this is a modular space ideal for exhibitions, product launches, screenings and performances.
